



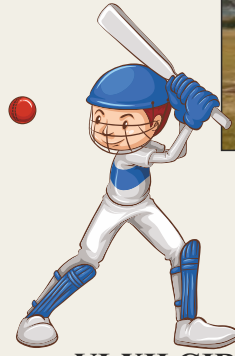

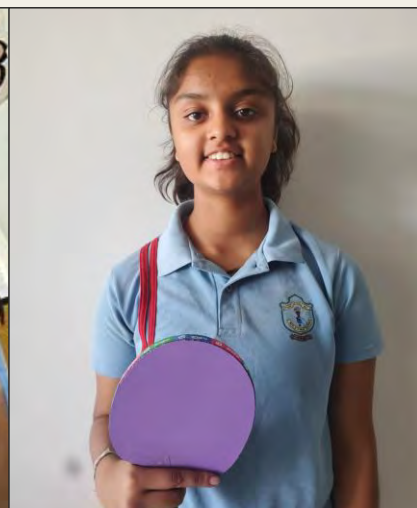

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Saral Creations Experiential Learning Trip: (XI-Com.)

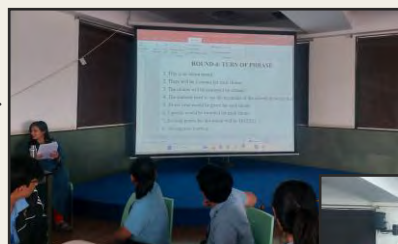

Inter House Vocabee Competition

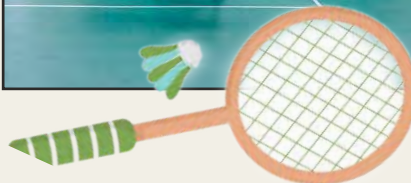

Their dedication and enthusiasm were instrumental in making the event a resounding success.

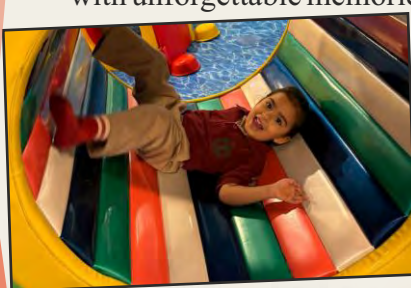


Experiential Learning Excursion to Bouncy Bunny
